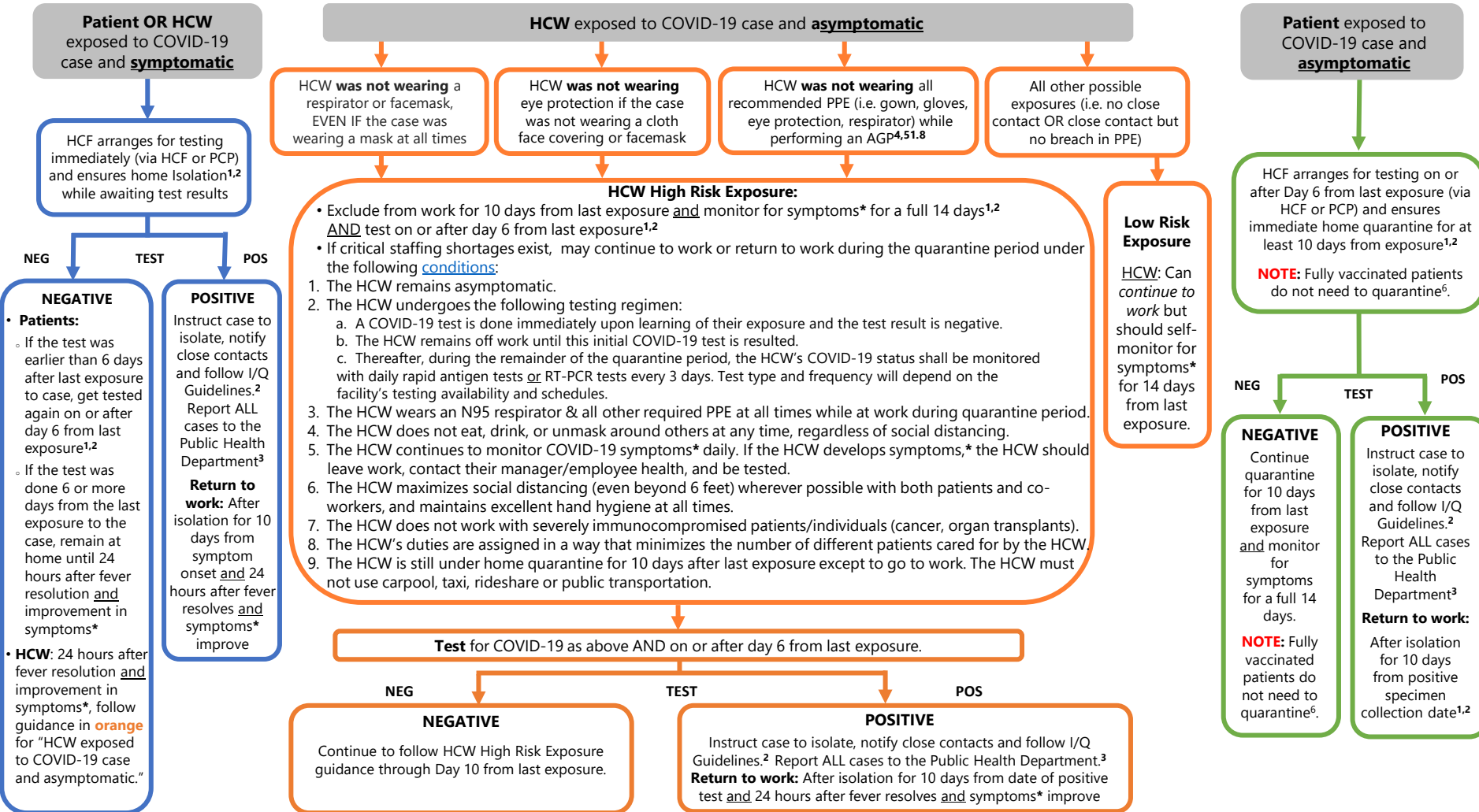


Healthcare Facilities (HCF) Exposure Management Guidelines

Healthcare workers (HCW) should follow any specific guidance given by their employer. For organizations that do not have an Infection Prevention or Occupational Health Department, please follow the guidance below.
Fully vaccinated healthcare workers are not required to quarantine outside of work⁶



***COVID-19 symptoms:**

Fever (100°F/37.8°C) or chills, Cough, Fatigue, Headache, Sore Throat, Muscle or Body Aches, Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing, Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea, Loss of Taste or Smell
