












19% increase in tuberculosis (TB) cases from 2022 to 2023









CHARACTERISTICS (N = 168)

- 36% had at least one comorbidity (similar to 2022)
- 26% had diabetes mellitus, the most common comorbidity (similar to 2022)
- the four first-line drugs (decreased from 17% in 2022)
- 8% died with TB or while on TB treatment (increased from 6% in 2022)
