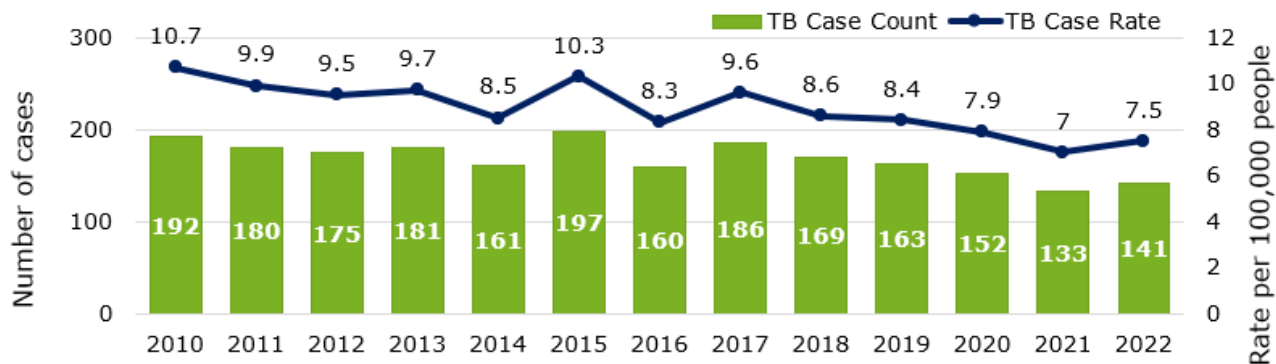
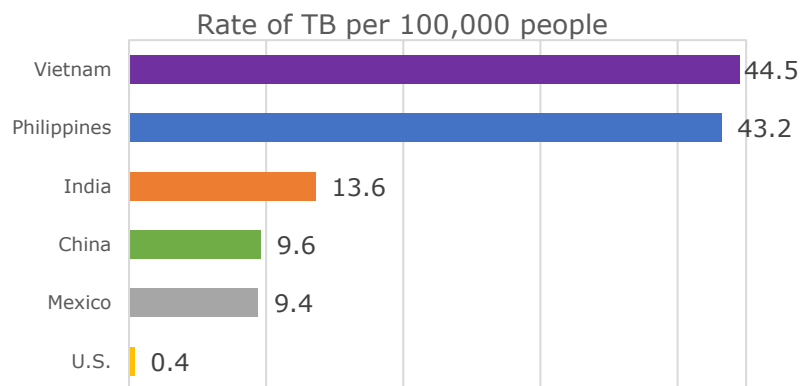
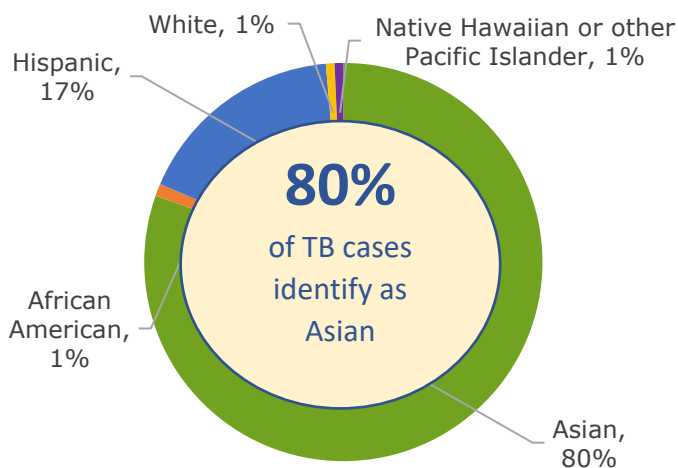


TUBERCULOSIS

2022 data for Santa Clara County



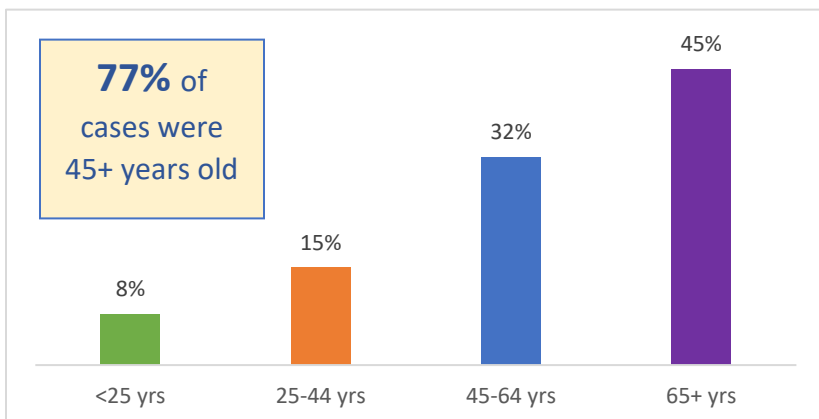
6% increase

77% of cases born outside the U.S. have lived here for **5+ years**



CHARACTERISTICS (N 141)

- 26% had diabetes mellitus, the most common comorbidity (decreased from 28% in 2021)
- 36% had at least one comorbidity (decreased from 47% in 2021)
- 17% displayed resistance to any of the four first line drugs (increased from 15% in 2021)
- 6% died with TB or while on TB treatment (decreased from 8% in 2021)
