



Dear Healthcare Provider,

The County of Santa Clara Public Health Department would like to remind you that COVID-19 vaccines can be administered along with all other childhood vaccinations in the same visit. TB tests can also be done any time before, during the same visit, or any time after COVID-19 vaccination. COVID-19 vaccines should be offered to patients age 5 or older in accordance with CDC guidance. Please do not delay vaccine administration, as this is not recommended by the CDC.

Your patient's school has provided the following information about missed vaccinations for your patient. Once your patient has received their missing vaccinations, the school requests that you provide the updated vaccination record to the patient's parent/guardian to provide to the school or that you send the updated vaccination record directly to the school via the contact information provided below.
