Protected from RSV



The first immunization to protect infants against respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) is available.



RSV is the most common cause of hospitalization in children younger than 1 year of age.



If the vaccine was not received by the birth parent during pregnancy, infants younger than 8 months should receive a dose of Nirsevamib (Beyfortus) during RSV season.
