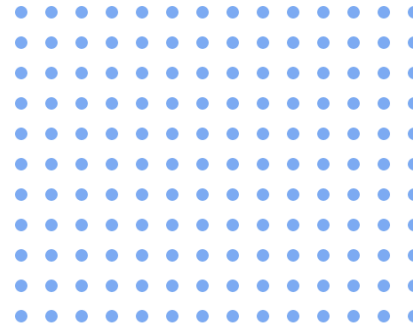


The Shared Portal for Outbreak Tracking (SPOT)

Why SPOT?

The **Shared Portal for Outbreak Tracking (SPOT)** supports efforts to expand California's COVID-19 case and outbreak response efforts by facilitating collaboration and sharing of information between schools, workplaces, or healthcare facilities and their local health departments through CalCONNECT, California's public health data management system. SPOT is one of several tools that can assist these entities in complying with state and local reporting requirements.



How do I use SPOT?

SPOT is a place for schools, workplaces, and healthcare facilities to **report information about COVID-19 cases and/or outbreaks** at their location. The information is sent to CalCONNECT, allowing the Santa Clara County Public Health Department to review the information and use it to initiate important outbreak response efforts.
